

Legislative – MARK ZINSER - "Zman" LEGISLATIVE REPORT JUNE 2023 NEWSLETTER EPA to Allow Summer Sales of E1

Friday, the Biden Administration issued an emergency waiver allowing for the sale of E15 from June 1st to September 15th. Restrictions on fuel volatility have limited the sale of E15 to the months outside of summer. This move by the Biden Administration is an attempt to appease lawmakers from corn producing states, who for years have lobbied for year-round use of the fuel. A similar emergency waiver was issued in 2022.

As always read your owner's manual, know what you are putting in your bike, and be an educated consumer.

FROM THE AMA: Olympia, Wash. — House Bill 1112, after passing both houses of the legislature unanimously, has been sent to Governor Inslee for his consideration. It creates the new offense of Negligent Driving with a Vulnerable User Victim in the first degree as a gross misdemeanor. A person commits the offense if the person operates a vehicle in a manner that is both negligent and endangers or is likely to endanger any person or property, and proximately causes the death of a vulnerable user of a public way.

The offense is punishable by up to 364 days of imprisonment; a \$5,000 fine, which may not be reduced below \$1,000; and suspension of driving privileges for 90 days. The offense of Negligent Driving in the second degree with a Vulnerable User Victim is renamed to Negligent Driving with a Vulnerable User Victim in the second degree, and the scope of the offense is modified. A person commits the offense if the person operates a vehicle in a manner that is both negligent and endangers or is likely to endanger any person or property, and proximately causes great bodily harm or substantial bodily harm of a vulnerable user of a public way.

For the purposes of this legislation, a vulnerable user means:

- •a pedestrian
- •a person riding an animal
- •a person operating or riding a farm tractor or implement of husbandry, without an enclosed shell
- •a bicycle or electric-assisted bicycle
- •an electric personal assistive mobility device
- •a moped and a motor-driven cycle or a motorcycle

whereas may is National Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month, and Florida's growing population popularity with motorcycle enthusiasts makes motorcycle safety an important issue; and

WHEREAS according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 593 motorcyclists lost their lives in fatal Florida highway crashes in 2021, and over 50 percent of them consistently involved another vehicle, and

WHEREAS approximately 80 percent of vehicle crashes injure or kill a motorcycle rider, and victims are 37 times more likely to die in a traffic crash than occupants in passenger vehicles, motorcyclists are much more vulnerable than other motorists in the event of a collision and motorcycle riders now account for one out of every ten U.S. road statilities: and

WHEREAS motorcyclists are often hidden in a vehicle's blind spot or missed in a quick look due to their smaller size, and making a visual check for motorcycles by intentionally viewing mirrors and blind spots before entering or leaving a lane of traffic and at interactions

WHEREAS during warmer weather months, even more, motorcycles are on the road and because motorcycles are often difficult to see; therefore, people in other vehicles should be extra vigilant to leak for more seed that the

local highway safety and law enforcement organizations like the Florida Highway Patrol in proclaiming May as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month: and

WHEREAS the members of A.B.A.T.E. (American Bikers Aimed Towards Education) continually promote motorcycle safety, education, and awareness in high school drivers'

WHEREAS remembering motorcycles are vehicles with all the rights and privileges of

NOW, THEREFORE, I, H. William Mutz, Mayor of the City of Lakeland, and on behalf of the entire City Commission, do hereby proclaim May 2023, as

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH

Hi Polk County,

As you may have heard we had another win in Tallahassee. Governor DeSantis signed SB-838 to fund nonprofit motorcycle safety programs. Another example of our lobbying power at the Capitol. 


